



IOSH Safe Worker Passport.

Duration: One day.

Course overview:

The Safe Worker Passport covers the foundation health and safety knowledge and requirements for staff to work safely whilst visiting customers' sites.

The Safe Worker Passport offers an alternative passport to CCNSG and other industry schemes and can focus on non construction activities, relevant to each industry.

Upon completion of a written examination and practical test successful delegates are issued with a credit card sized passport confirming their achievement.

The card is valid for a period of three years, and is renewed for a further three years by the completion of a one day refresher programme.

IOSH confirm that "The Safe Worker Passport training is 100% compliant with the Health and Safety Executives Safety Passport Scheme."

Course content:

Upon completion the delegates will be able to:

- State the legal responsibilities of a safe worker.
- Explain the companies and employees legal requirements for health and safety.
- Describe the principles of safe working.
- Understand and apply a simple risk assessment.
- Describe the hazards associated with working and explain the appropriate safe working methods.
